This guide gives all the information needed to enjoy the 338km (210 mile) Severn Way. The book is divided into four sections that correspond to the four counties (Powys, Shropshire, Worcestershire and Gloucestershire) through which the River Severn flows on its way to the sea. The route is easily accessed by bus and rail, making it suitable to walk in easy stages and over repeat visits, and it can be enjoyed at any time of year.

Beginning at the river's source on the wild mid-Wales Plynlimon plateau, the Severn Way pulls together interesting threads of history, trade and commerce as it meanders to its end at Severn Beach, near Bristol. Along the way, the Severn - the longest UK river - passes superb landscapes such as Hafren Forest and reaches many appealing towns and villages.

Step-by-step route description is accompanied by OS map extracts, and the guidebook is packed with historical and geographical information about the places along the way

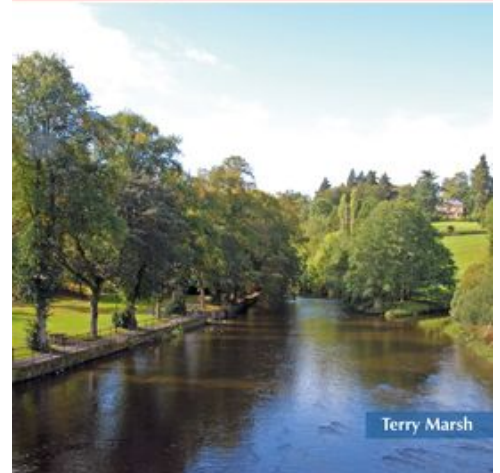
