This guide presents 50 hillwalks in the northwest Highlands, with Kinlochewe, Ullapool, Lochcarron and Achnasheen serving as potential bases for a walking holiday. The mountains are the main attraction and the routes include ascents of 27 Munros, 20 Corbetts and 15 Grahams, with highlights including Liathach, Beinn Eighe, Beinn Alligin, An Teallach and Slioch. They are suited to those with experience of mountain walking as they call for good fitness and competent navigation skills, and a few involve scrambling.

The walks are graded, with summary statistics provided. Each includes clear route description and mapping. Divided between three areas – Northern Torridon, Southern Torridon and Fisherfield and the Fannichs (between Loch Maree and Loch Broom), they take in well-known Munros and little-visited gems, with multiple ascent options offered for the major peaks. Also included are a handful of traverse routes and the celebrated Fisherfield Six.

The region boasts spectacular and distinctive landscapes and breathtaking views. Steep-sided rocky mountains rise above long winding lochs, both freshwater and sea. From the hills there are vast panoramas out across the sea to the Hebrides and of mountains stretching out to the north, south and east.
