This guide describes 45 graded circular walks of 4–24km in the beautiful Brecon Beacons National Park, covering the north-eastern, eastern and south-western valleys and ridges, Fforest Fawr, Waterfall Country, the Black Mountain (Mynydd Du) and the Black Mountains (y Mynyddoedd Duon).

Walking in the Brecon Beacons invites you to explore on your own, enjoying the solitude, tranquillity and wilderness, but with all the interesting facts at your fingertips that an expert park ranger would provide. The guide is packed with information on local geology, botany, archaeology, history and environmental issues. Clear route description is illustrated with 1:50,000 OS Landranger mapping, summary statistics are provided for each walk and handy tables make it easy to compare routes or choose according to points of interest.

The walks tend to avoid the better-known routes, although classics such as Pen y Fan are included. They showcase the diverse landscapes of this attractive region, ranging from waterfalls and wooded river gorges to mountain peaks and ridges and remote upland wilderness.
