The 24 walks in this guidebook use good paths and tracks as well as quiet country roads, while occasional more rugged paths explore the island's excellent cliff coastline. Walking is generally easy, ranging from 2 to 8 miles in length, although they can be joined together to create longer challenges, such as the Jersey Coastal Walk, and the Channel Islands Way.

Famous for its sunshine, history and wonderful coastline, Jersey is an intriguing destination for travellers. Outwardly British but with French overtones, it is a compact island often busy with visitors - who have a lot to fit in if they want to experience everything the island has to offer.

Alongside detailed route descriptions are 1:25:000 maps from the States of Jersey Official Leisure Map of Jersey and information about points of interest for every walk. There are thorough introductions on Jersey's history, geology, culture and wildlife, as well as a wealth of practical information on getting to and around Jersey, language and accommodation.

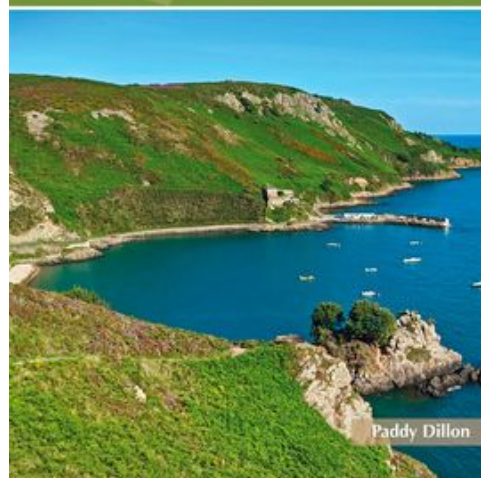
About the author
