Volume 1 of a two-part set, this guide details 69 exciting and challenging routes to climb 139 Munros – the Scottish mountains over 3000ft. Suitable for those with experience of mountain walking, some routes require scrambling while others include the option to cycle a section of the journey.

The Munros boast some of the most dramatic mountain scenery in Britain. This volume covers the southern, central and western highlands, featuring stunning regions such as Glen Coe, Glen Shee and the Isle of Mull, the Mamores, Grey Corries and Arrochar Alps.

Alongside 1:100K mapping, the guide provides comprehensive information on tackling this famous collection of mountains with useful details on Gaelic names, accommodation and access. Also included is a full list of all 282 Munros — a useful resource for peak-baggers.

Volume 2 covers the Munros of the northern highlands and Cairngorms.

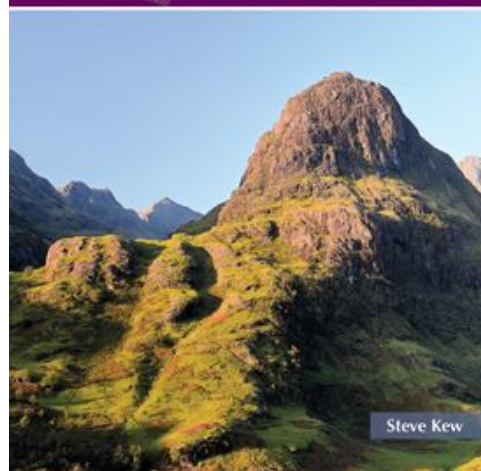
