With 80 routes, this guide offers walkers many opportunities to explore the 'Jolly Green Giants' of Highland Perthshire. Bound by the Cairngorms to the north, Stirling to the south and stretching to Bridge of Orchy in the west, the graded hikes include all 42 Munros in the region. In addition, the guide covers 22 selected Corbetts, 15 smaller (but notable) hills, low-level routes in 'Big Tree Country' and the historic passes of Gaick and Minigaig. Routes range from 2.5km to 45km and from leisurely low-level strolls to long and strenuous mountain routes involving steep ascents and descents, remote and rough terrain and navigational challenge.

This guide offers the best and often most unconventional routes to the mountains of the region, with four receiving special attention: Ben Lawers, Beinn Dorain, Ben Alder and Beinn a' Ghlò. With detailed route descriptions, clear maps and invaluable advice, it is the perfect companion to exploring Perthshire's mountains, hills and valleys.
