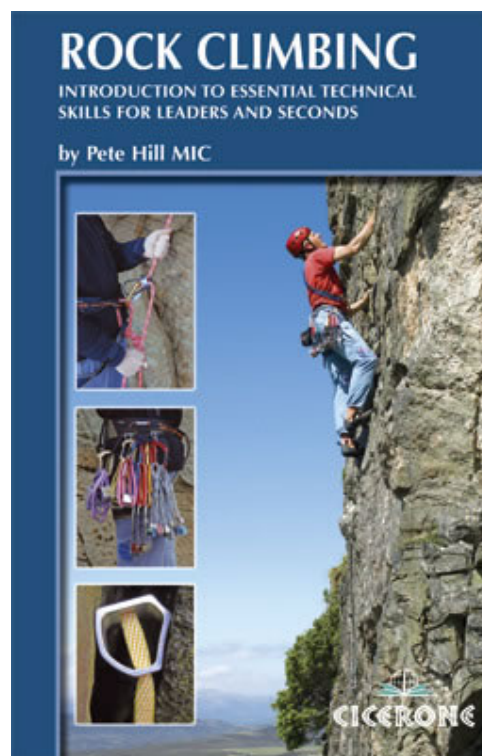
About the author
