The GTMC is a long-distance mountain biking trail that crosses the entire Massif Central in France, from Clermont-Ferrand in the north to Montpellier and the Mediterranean Coast at Sète. All of the major regions of the Massif Central are visited, including the Auvergne, the Cézaillier plateau and the remote Margeride, the high forested hills of the Cévennes National Park and the limestone hills bordering the coastal plain.

Much of the route is off-road and uses many Grandes Randonnées, so it also makes an excellent walking route. Just over 700km in length it offers a challenge to the mountain biker or walker, as well as the pleasure of exploring one of southern France's most beautiful and historic regions.

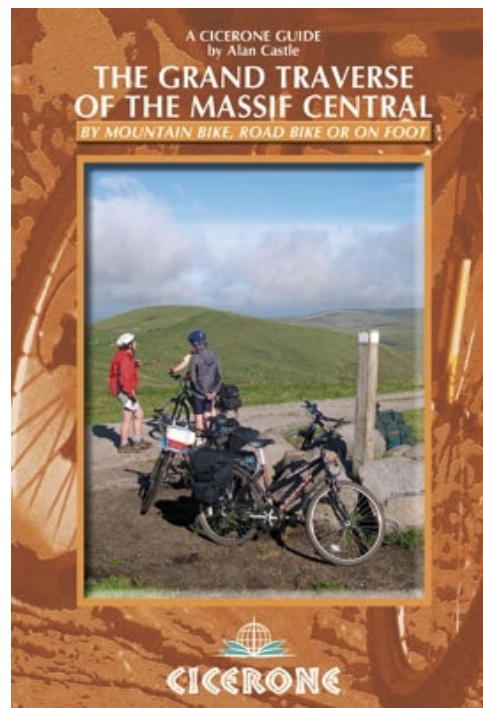
