The West Highland Way is one of Britain's finest long-distance paths. It passes through six separate mountain ranges, from the elegant cone of Ben Lomond and the crag towers of Glen Coe to the seductive Mamores.

It runs along Glens Falloch and Fillan, close to the Highlands- second busiest main road and the West Highland Railway, but doesn't include the enticing Stobs and Bens. It may be Scotland's best long-distance path, but this book intends to do better.

So for those with a desire to see more, here are Ben Lomond and Beinn Dorain, the charming Campsie Fells, and the mighty Mamores; and the best pub-to-pub in these islands, the crossing of the Black Mount from Inveroran to Glen Coe.

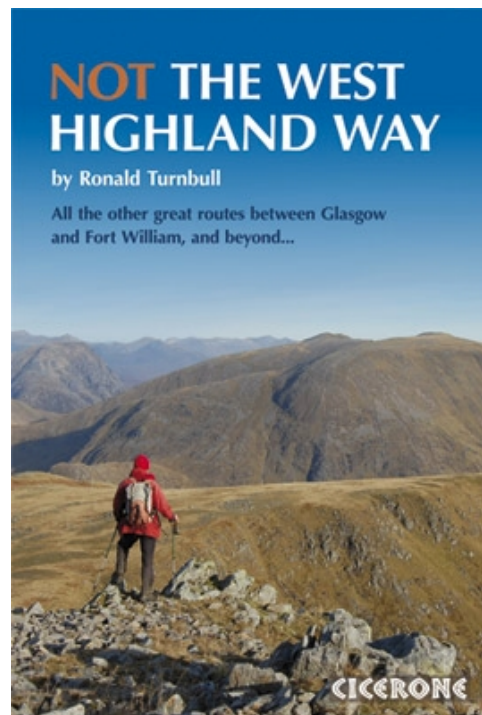
