Numerous walking books have been written about the Peak District, home of Britain's first and most visited national park, which covers roughly half of Derbyshire. This guide has a broader scope. It offers comprehensive coverage of the whole county, including the Peak District but also the contrasting landscapes south of Ashbourne and Derby.

The 60 day walks described in detail here are set against the backdrop of the varied and beautiful Derbyshire landscape and cover an extensive range of historical themes. Routes pass remnants of ancient civilisations, fine market towns and villages, caverns, castles, country houses and parklands, historic spa resorts and industrial heritage sites. The book is full of background information for walkers to appreciate local history.

Walks range between 2 and 10 miles long, over a wide variety of terrain, offering something for walkers of all abilities. All this lies in the heart of England, with excellent accessibility from all parts of Britain.

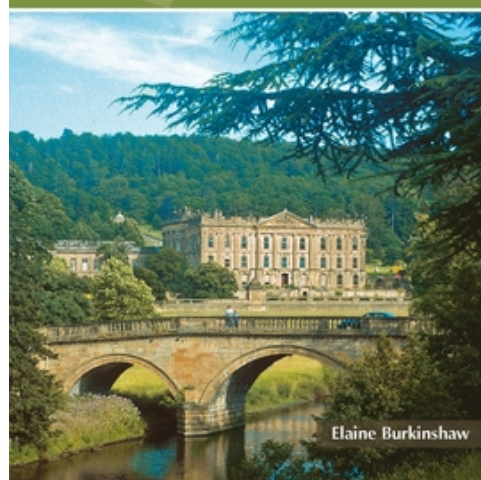
