This guidebook, one of a two-volume set, describes hikes up all 112 Corbetts (Scotland's 2500-2999ft mountains) south of the Great Glen. They provide fantastic walking and many are still little-climbed, with hardly any experience of crowds. Few of the routes in the guide involve scrambling, but there is challenge to be had on the many steep slopes. They can be climbed at any time of year but the going can be relatively tough and navigation demanding in mist and poor weather. The guide is not intended primarily for peak baggers, who want the shortest, easiest option, but rather for walkers who want the best, most interesting routes.




