Geocaching, or high-tech treasure hunting, became possible in 2000, and from its first beginning in the US, it has grown to such an extent that there are now 2.4 million caches worldwide. Local groups hold regular events across the UK.

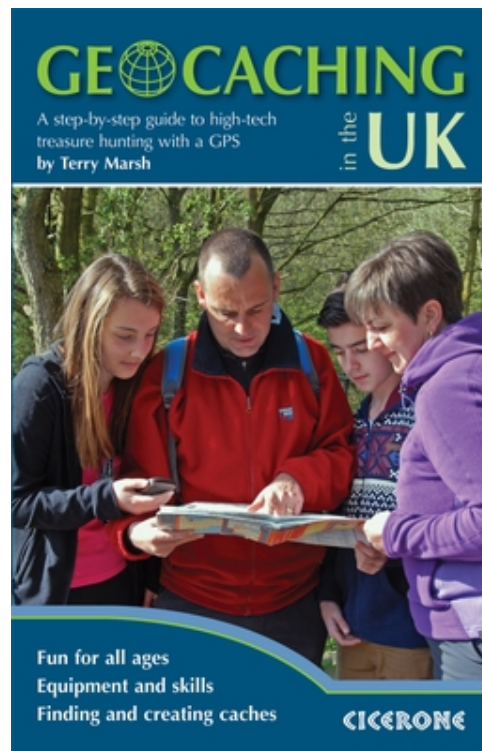
