Guidebook to the Pilgrims' Way, an ancient pilgrimage route across England from Winchester in Hampshire to Canterbury in Kent. The 138-mile walk, which is divided into stages of about 10 miles, takes in monuments, sites and churches of interest, including those significant to the martyred St Thomas Becket and other historical figures.

The pilgrimage which began as early as 1172, stemmed from the fatal stabbing of the Archbishop Becket in the Canterbury Cathedral in 1170. Pilgrims have walked the path ever since, with interest extending into the realm of literature and theatre.

A full description of the route is accompanied by 1:50,000 OS mapping, together with information on historical figures and points of interest along the way. A variation to the route – starting in Southwark, London – is also described, as is a diversion to Rochester Cathedral. Practical information is also included such as when to walk, where to stay, waymarking to look out for and refreshments en route.

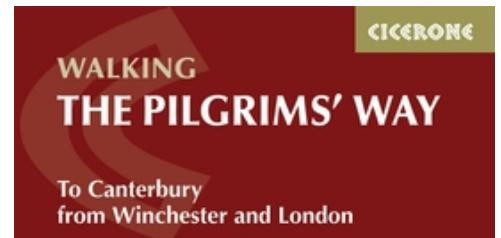
