Its superbly located resorts are connected by good roads and it is well served by cable-cars and lifts, which extend the range of the shorter routes and ease steep descents.

The walks are graded for difficulty and the guide gives all the important background and planning information you need as well as a useful Italian-German-English glossary. The area is a prime holiday destination for walkers and this guide will help you enjoy it every step of the way.
