This guidebook describes 40 day walks across Norfolk ranging in length from 4 to 12 miles. All walks are circular, along footpaths, bridleways and quiet country lanes, and some use parts of long-distance paths, including the Peddars Way, Norfolk Coast Path, Boudica's Way and Weavers Way. The walks are divided into five sections: the northeast coast and the Broads; south Norfolk, the Yare and Waveney; North Norfolk and the Coast; Central Norfolk and Breckland; and West Norfolk and the Fens.

Contrary to popular belief, Norfolk is made up of varied landscapes, and the walks in this book take in sandy beaches, shingle banks, watery fenland, ancient woodland and rolling pastoral farmland. The county's diverse habitats make it a great destination for walkers with an interest in natural history and wildlife, while its rich heritage and low levels of urbanisation will appeal to lovers of history.

Full route descriptions are given for all the walks, and each is accompanied by an extract from the OS 1:50,000 map blown up to 1:40,000 for greater clarity. They include advice on available refreshments and public transport, as well as background information on points of interest passed along the way.

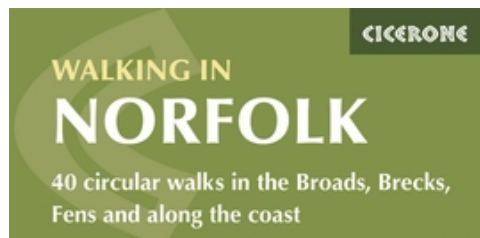
