This booklet of Ordnance Survey 1:25,000 Explorer maps has been designed for convenient use on the trail. It shows the full and up-to-date line of the National Trail, along with the relevant extract from the OS Explorer map legend. It can be used when walking the trail in either direction. Conveniently sized for slipping into a jacket pocket or top of a rucksack, it comes in a clear PVC sleeve and provides all of the mapping you need to complete the trail.

The Great Glen is one of Scotland's most remarkable features – a ruler-straight valley along an ancient Highland fault line. The glen is threaded by the scenic Caledonian Canal, linking Loch Lochy and Loch Oich with Loch Ness.

An accompanying Cicerone guidebook – *The Great Glen Way* / 978185288019 – describes the full route in both directions with lots of other practical and historical information, for those who prefer a written guide. **NOTE:** The accompanying guidebook includes a copy of this map booklet.

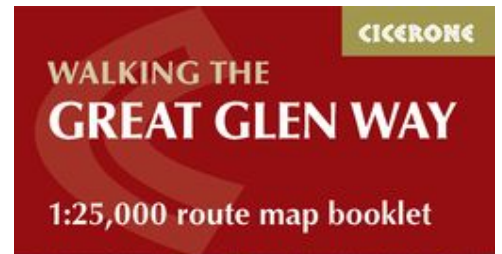
