The trail typically takes two weeks to walk in its entirety, but is equally suited to day walking. This compact booklet of Ordnance Survey 1:25,000 maps shows the full route, providing all of the mapping you need to complete the trail, and eliminating the need to fold and re-fold a large map.

An accompanying Cicerone guidebook – The Pembrokeshire Coast Path / 9781852848156 – describes the full route in both directions with lots of other practical and historical information, for those who prefer a written guide. NOTE: The accompanying guidebook includes a copy of this map booklet.

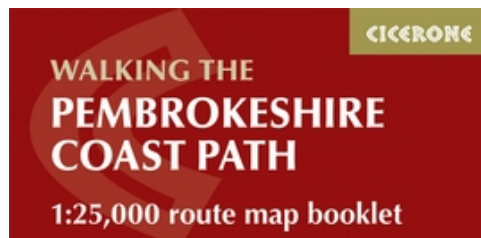
