Map of the West Highland Way, 152km (95 miles) from Milngavie on the outskirts of Glasgow to Fort William. The trail typically takes 8 days to walk in its entirety. This compact booklet of Ordnance Survey 1:25,000 maps shows the full route, providing all of the mapping you need to complete the trail, and eliminating the need to fold and re-fold a large map.

There is no faulting the West Highland Way: it takes in some of the best of Scotland all in one walk. Every day the landscape changes, offering new perspectives, new ways of seeing nature and new challenges, yet rarely does the Way stray far from outside help.

An accompanying Cicerone guidebook – the fourth edition of *The West Highland Way*/9781852848576 – describes the full route in both directions with lots of other practical and historical information, for those who prefer a written guide. 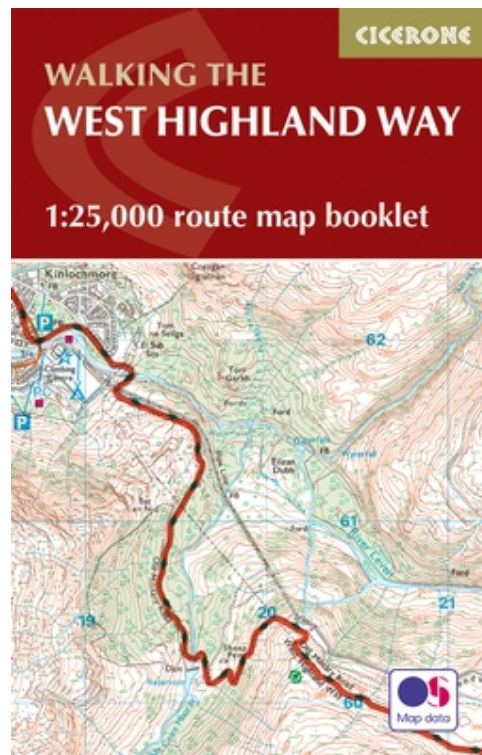
