This guidebook describes 50 day walks across England's 'last wilderness', the North Pennines. Ranging from 5 to 14 miles, the routes are primarily circular with a smaller selection of linear trails. From gentle riverside strolls to rugged moorland walks, there is a route to suit every ability.

Listed as an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, the North Pennines offers a rich and varied terrain from open moorland to ancient woodland. Intriguingly, it was also once the world's greatest producer of lead, giving it an industrial heritage which is well worth exploring.

Route descriptions are accompanied by 1:50,000 OS mapping which highlights the route, direction and points of interest along the way. The guidebook also provides background information on local wildlife, flora, geology, as well as public transport options for getting to and from the start/finish points of each route.

Paddy Dillon is a prolific outdoor writer with over 70 guidebooks to his name, and contributions to 30 other publications. He has written for a variety of outdoor magazines, as well as many booklets and brochures for tourism organisations. 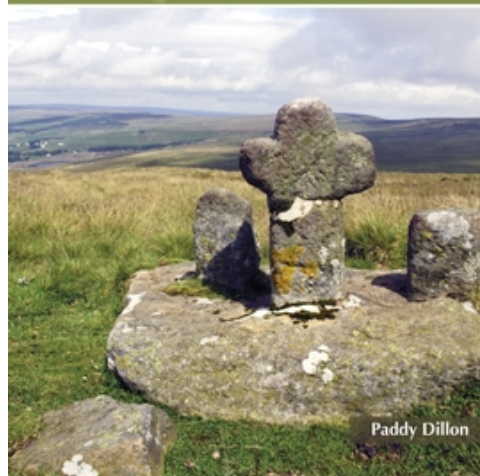
