This map booklet shows the 427km (265½ mile) Pennine Way. This National Trail – Britain's oldest, toughest and best-known long-distance footpath – stretches from Edale in the Derbyshire Peak District to Kirk Yetholm in the Scottish Borders and can be completed in 2-3 weeks.

This booklet of Ordnance Survey 1:25,000 Explorer maps has been designed for convenient use on the trail, providing all the mapping you need to complete the Pennine Way. It shows the full and up-to-date line of the National Trail, along with the relevant extract from the OS Explorer map legend. Conveniently sized for slipping into a jacket pocket or top of a rucksack and with a clear PVC sleeve, the compact format eliminates the need to fold and re-fold a large map or to carry several maps.

The Pennine Way crosses three National Parks – the Peak District, Yorkshire Dales and Northumberland National Park. It also visits the North Pennines Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Hadrian's Wall.

An accompanying Cicerone guidebook – The Pennine Way / 9781852849061 – describes the full route with lots of other practical planning and background information, for those who prefer a written guide. NOTE: The accompanying guidebook includes a copy of this map booklet.



