A comprehensive guide to walking in the Azores. The guidebook is divided into three island groups: Eastern Group (covering São Miguel and Santa Maria); Central Group (Terceira, Graciosa, São Jorge, Pico and Faial); and Western Group (Flores and Corvo). Most of the 70 routes presented here use the Azores' official waymarked trail network and range from hour-long strolls to full-day outings.

Lying in the North Atlantic Ocean the Azores are an archipelago of nine lush green islands 850 miles west of Portugal. The mild climate makes this an ideal destination for year-round walking.

The guidebook gives lots of practical information on travel to the Azores and between the different islands, as well as getting around by public transport. Full route descriptions are accompanied by 1:50,000 scale map extracts.

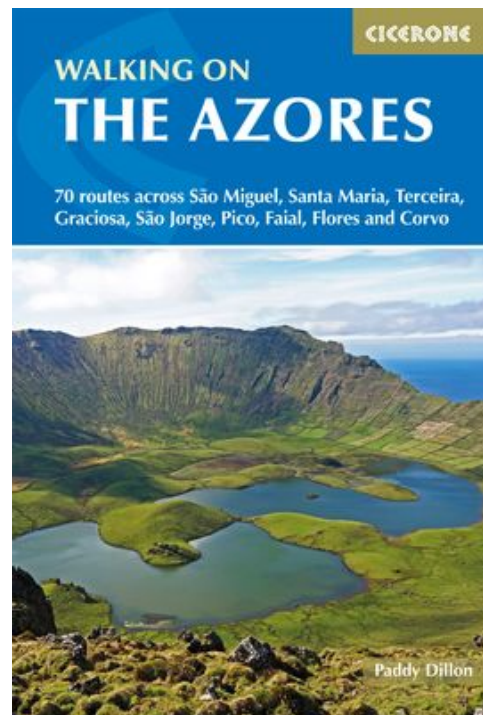
