This map booklet shows the 87-mile (139km) Ridgeway National Trail through the south of England from Avebury in Wiltshire to Ivinghoe Beacon in Buckinghamshire. Presented in 12 stages, the trail can be walked in as little as a week, although 8 days would be a more comfortable schedule, and 10 or 12 day itinerary would allow more time to explore the sights along the way.

This compact booklet Ordnance Survey 1:25,000 maps has been designed for convenient use on the trail. It shows the full and up-to-date line of the National Trail, along with the relevant extract from the OS Explorer map legend. It can be used when walking the route in either direction. Conveniently sized for slipping into a jacket pocket or into the top of a rucksack, it comes in a clear PVC sleeve and provides all of the mapping you need to complete the route.

An accompanying Cicerone guidebook – The Ridgeway National Trail / 9781852848743 – describes the full route with lots of other practical planning and background information, for those who prefer a written guide. NOTE: The accompanying guidebook includes a copy of this map booklet.

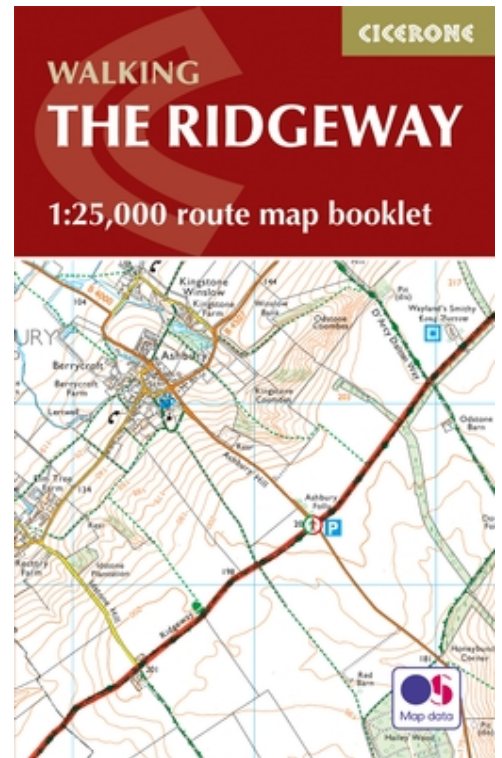
