This map booklet shows the Speyside Way, an official 66-mile (106km) Scottish Long Distance Route which follows the River Spey through northern Scotland from Aviemore to the old port of Buckie on the Moray coast. With easy walking on good paths and along disused railway lines, the route is divided into 10 stages of between 2 and 13 miles (3–21km).

This booklet of Ordnance Survey 1:25,000 Explorer maps has been designed for convenient use on the trail. It shows the full and up-to-date line of the route, along with the relevant extract from the OS Explorer map legend. Conveniently sized for slipping into a jacket pocket or top of a rucksack, it comes in a clear PVC sleeve and provides all of the mapping you need to complete the trail.

An accompanying Cicerone guidebook – *The Speyside Way* / 9781852848682 – describes the full route with lots of other practical planning and background information, for those who prefer a written guide. NOTE: The accompanying guidebook includes a copy of this map booklet.
