This compact map booklet contains all the OS 1:25,000 mapping needed to complete the Dales Way, a scenic, 79 mile route between Ilkley and Bowness-on-Windermere, linking the Yorkshire Dales with the Lake District. Well served for accommodation and facilities, and with easy walking on riverside paths, the Dales Way is one of the gentlest multi-day walks in Britain and therefore an ideal introduction to long-distance walking. It can be comfortably completed in 6–8 days.

This booklet has been designed for convenient use on the trail and eliminates the need to carry multiple maps and to fold and re-fold a large map. It shows the full and up-to-date line of the Dales Way, along with the relevant extract from the OS Explorer map legend. Conveniently sized for slipping into a jacket pocket or the top of a rucksack, it comes in a clear PVC sleeve and provides all of the mapping you need to complete the trail.

An accompanying Cicerone guidebook – The Dales Way / 9781852849436 – describes the full route in both directions with lots of other practical and historical information, for those who prefer a written guide. NOTE: The accompanying guidebook includes a copy of this map booklet.



