



NORTH DOWNS WAY MAP BOOKLET

This map booklet shows the 130 mile (208km) North Downs Way National Trail between Farnham and Dover, with an optional spur to Canterbury. The trail is suitable for walkers at all levels of experience and can be walked at any time of the year.

This booklet of Ordnance Survey 1:25,000 Explorer maps has been designed for convenient use on the trail. Maps show the line of the National Trail, along with the relevant extract from the OS Explorer map legend. Conveniently sized for slipping into a jacket pocket or top of a rucksack, it comes in a clear PVC sleeve and provides all of the mapping you need to complete the trail.

An accompanying Cicerone guidebook – *The North Downs Way* / 9781852848613 – describes the full route with lots of other practical and historical information, for those who prefer a written guide. NOTE: The accompanying guidebook includes a copy of this map booklet.
