This guidebook provides 42 walking routes in the eastern part of the White Peak area of the Peak District. It is the first book in a two-volume set for walking in the White Peak and features a range of routes to suit all walkers in all weathers. Alongside 35 day walks, the guide offers information about the long distance trails in the area that can be used to link day walks into longer multi-day trips and the 66km (41 mile) White Peak Circular, which starts and finishes in Birchover and can be completed in three days.

The gentle rolling hills of the Peak District are lined with limestone escarpments and full of historical sites and quaint villages where traditional customs thrive. Whether visiting industrial mills and limestone quarries, local churches or the grounds of Chatsworth, these walks showcase the most fascinating aspects of Derbyshire's history and geology.

The guide provides OS mapping for each walk and detailed route description, alongside insights into local history and culture. It also includes a route summary table to aid planning and an appendix of useful websites.



