This guide provides 30 low-level and easy walks in Snowdonia. Ranging from 3km to 19km, these day walks are suitable for all ages and abilities and can be experienced all year round. Covering the southern part of the national park, the walks are based around Harlech, the Mawddach Estuary, Aber Dyfi and Machynlleth.

Snowdonia is a coastal mountain range offering rugged mountains, expansive moorland and vibrant estuaries reaching down to the sea. These walks also explore impressive waterfalls in ancient woodland, peaceful lakes and historic sites including Bronze Age cairns, Roman forts and 13th century castles.

For all 30 walks, this guidebook provides Ordnance Survey (OS) mapping, parking and access, detailed route description and plenty of insights into local history, wildlife and geology. The guide also includes a route summary table to aid planning and an appendix of useful contacts.

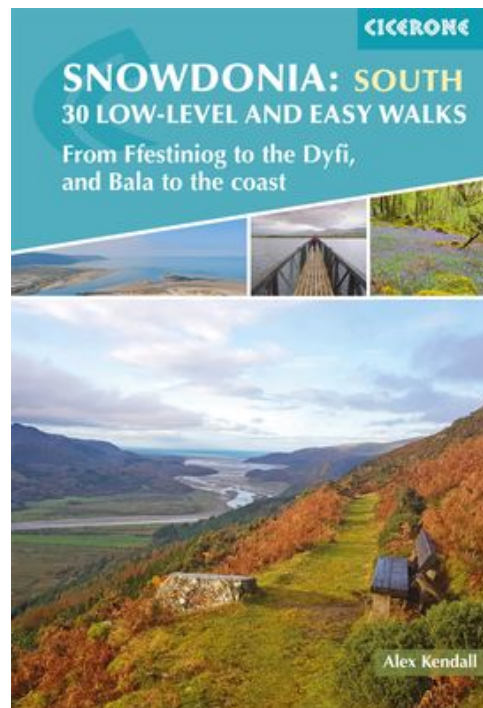
